

Petition under Section 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondent no. 1 & 2 to consider the petitioners for the posts of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male) as no candidate is being considered from the rest of the country except from nine institutes situated in the state of Haryana and there is no machinery provided for seeking approval as there is no legislature to regulate this field of elementary health care in state of Haryana.

WITH further prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction for staying the interview / selection of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male) being conducted by the respondent no. 1 & 2 since Oct.28, 2013 or in the alternative permitting the petitioners to participate in the interview provisionally subject to the final orders of this hon'ble court.

Respectfully States:-

1. That the petitioners, being the citizen of India, are in a position to invoke the writ jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by way of filing the present writ petition.
2. That the precise grievance of the petitioners is that they are not being allowed to be interviewed for the post of multipurpose health worker (male) only on the ground that they have done the course from institutes not approved by the state of Haryana, even though there is no machinery set up to give approval to any institutes situated outside
